Patient Instructions to Prepare for Procedure

If you are pregnant or think you might be, notify your physician prior to your scheduled appointment date.

Please follow directions as checked below:

- Barium Swallow:** Nothing to eat or drink after midnight.
- Upper Gastrointestinal Series:** Nothing to eat or drink after midnight.
- Small Bowel Series:** Nothing to eat or drink after midnight.
- Barium Enema:** Clear liquid diet day before the exam. At 7:00 p.m., please take 4 Dulcolax Tablets. Nothing to eat or drink after midnight. Morning of exam, begin taking cleansing enemas. Repeat enemas until enema results are clear.
- Barium Enema with air Contrast:**
 - 2 days prior to exam: Clear liquid diet 48 hours prior to exam – this includes breakfast, lunch and dinner. At 7:00 p.m. 2 days prior to exam – please take 4 Dulcolax Tablets with 4 ounces of water.
 - One day prior to exam: continue clear liquid diet. Take 4 Dulcolax Tablets with glass of water. Nothing by mouth until time of exam. At 6:00 a.m. day of the exam, begin taking cleansing enemas.
 - Repeat enemas until results are clear.
- Intravenous Pyelogram:** Take 4 Dulcolax Tablets at 7:00 p.m. evening prior to exam and begin clear liquid diet until exam is performed.
- Hepatobiliary (HIDA) Nuclear Medicine Scan:** Nothing to eat or drink after midnight.
- Cardiolite/Myocardial Perfusion Nuclear Medicine Scan** – Nothing to eat or drink after midnight. Wear comfortable clothing and shoes. Do not take any medications. Please bring all medications with you. Procedure time is approximately 5 hours.
- Ultrasound Abdomen:** Nothing to eat or drink after midnight.
- Ultrasound Pelvis:** Full bladder is required for this exam. Drink four 8-ounce glasses of water one hour before the exam.
- Mammogram:** Wear two-piece outfit. No deodorant, perfume, lotion or powders under the arms or on the breast before the exam.



DIRECTIONS TO SPARTANBURG REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER

On Business 85, take exit 5A(I-585/Pine Street) toward downtown Spartanburg. Go 1.5 miles, take exit 25B (Hwy.221/Church Street) and turn right at bottom of exit ramp. At the first traffic light, merge left onto North Church Street. At the third traffic light, turn left onto Catawba Street. The Regional Outpatient Center is located on the left side of Catawba Street and parking is located on the right. For handicap parking, please see parking attendant in front of the Regional Outpatient Center.
